1. Scope of approval

4. Privileges

(a) The holder of this design organisation approval shall be entitled to perform design activities under Part 21 and within its scope of approval.

(c) The holder of this design organisation approval shall be entitled, within its terms of approval and under the relevant procedures of the design assurance system:

3. to issue information or instructions containing the following statement: "The technical content of this document is approved under the authority of DOA ref. EASA.21J.487".
4. to approve documentary changes to the aircraft flight manual and supplements, and issue such changes containing the following statement: "Revision nr. xx to AFM (or supplement) ref. yyy is approved under the authority of DOA ref. EASA.21J.487."
